#### **DIVINE CALLING**

## Sunday ...... Read John 20:16-21

"Then said Jesus to them again, Peace be unto you: as my Father hath sent me, even so send I you." God the Father sent Jesus into the world to bring humans into His eternal family. ## Monday..... Read John 1:10-13
