DAILY BIBLE READINGS - Week of June 29, 2025 "Biblical Personalities: Zephaniah" BELIEVERS' JOY

SundayRead Zephaniah 3:14-20

"Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and rejoice with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem." One of the great benefits of those who have placed their faith in God and His Word is the joy God provides. One of the great things that brings joy is God's prophetic truth. Much of the Holy Scriptures is God's revelation of coming events. Those who have placed their faith in God and His eternal truth have the benefit of preparing for that which will happen. GOD'S AWARENESS

MondayRead Zephaniah 1:10-12

"And it shall come to pass at that time, that I will search Jerusalem with candles, and punish the men that are settled on their lees: that say in their heart, The Lord will not do good, neither will he do evil." The prophet Zephaniah emphasized that God was very aware of what was happening with His chosen people. He saw the waywardness of many, and He saw the faithfulness of those committed to pleasing Him. This should be a reminder to all in the world today. By recognizing God's awareness of world events and our personal lives, we should do all we can to please Him. We can be confident that God will prevail in world circumstances, giving believers a peace in the midst of all the turmoil in the world! GOD'S PLEASURE

Tuesday..... Read Isaiah 46:8-11

"Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure." GATHERINGS

WednesdayRead Zephaniah 2:1-2

"Gather yourselves together, yea, gather together, O nation not desired." God does not expect His people to go at it alone. In the Church Age, all believers are expected to be part of a body of believers. We call it local churches. The early believers formed local assemblies in the communities where they lived. The believers were God's light in the community to penetrate the darkness of the world. To open a person's eyes to the light of the gospel is the best thing we can do for anyone! ThursdayRead Romans 5:1-2

Jesus, the Savior of the world, is at the right hand of God in heaven. It is because of Jesus paying the penalty for sinners that gives believers access to God's throne. We have the joy and peace of knowing that our Savior and Lord is there interceding for us. GOD'S ADVICE

FridayRead Zephaniah 3:5-7

" I said, Surely thou wilt fear me, thou wilt receive instruction; so their dwelling should not be cut off, howsoever I punished them: but they rose early, and corrupted all their doings." Of all the counselors in the world, the best one is God. Praise God that by the work of the Holy Spirit, we have the Bible. God has put into writing His thoughts. Saturday Read Isaiah 30:18-21
