

**DAILY BIBLE READINGS - Week of April 26, 2026**

**"Heaven"  
GOD'S GLORY**

**Sunday ..... Read Psalm 19:1-10**

*"The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handiwork."* Whenever we look up at the sky, we see the glory of God. If it is the daytime, we see the sun and the beautiful clouds with sky blue in the background. At night we see the moon and the stars. It is God who arranged the day and the night and the seven day week. All that before He created the human being. What a shame that so many today would rather believe in a theory of evolution rather than give God the glory for His marvelous creations. But God is honored by those who engage in the worship of Him as our Creator of heaven and earth!

**DEITY OF JESUS**

**Monday ..... Read John 1:1-10**

*"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God."* The apostle John made it clear that Jesus was involved in the creation. He referred to Jesus as the Word, the Living Expression of God in a human body of flesh and bones. Jesus was God in the flesh. The Bible makes it clear why God the Son took on a human body. By so doing Jesus could pay the penalty of sin with His blood! This has to be the greatest demonstration of love in all of history. The love of God the Father for the people in the world that He made a way to pardon us from the penalty of sin. Being holy, God did not overlook sin, He had His own sinless Son become the blood sacrifice! Being God, Jesus conquered death with a glorious resurrection. He now is our living Savior and also the coming King of kings.

**TRIUNE BEINGS**

**Tuesday ..... Read John 60:1-3**

*"It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit, and they are life."* Having been made in the image of God, each of us is a triune being: body, soul, and spirit. God made the human a triune being so we could enjoy both the physical and spiritual world. At birth we all had an eternal soul with a living body and a dead spirit. We were alive to the physical world, but dead to the spiritual world. That spirit can be regenerated only by receiving Jesus. That decision to receive Jesus is a new birth. Jesus pointed that out in John 3:7 *"Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again."* Another important point about being made in the image of God is the human an eternal being. The soul is eternal, there are two destinations: heaven and hell.

Those with regenerated spirits by faith in Jesus as Savior go to heaven. Unbelievers end up I hell.

### **GOD'S THRONE**

**Wednesday ..... Read Revelation 20:1-15**

*"And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand."* The focal point of heaven has to be the throne of God. It has to be far more impressive than anything we can imagine. What is most impressive is the fact that God is sitting on the throne! One of the most impressive verses in Scripture for believers is found in Hebrews 4:16: *"Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."* That has to be our highest privilege in life o speak personally to God. God makes this promise to us in Jeremiah 33:3: *"Call unto me, and I will answer thee, and show thee great and mighty things, which thou knowest not."*

### **BELIEVERS' HOME**

**Thursday ..... Read John 14:1-3**

*" In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you."* That third verse is one of most personalized verses in the Bible. It is a promise that Jesus makes to every believer. We have a home in the eternal city of God. That is true for every believer! Think of it! Who will be my neighbor? Will it be someone in my family? Will it be someone in my local church? Will it be a Bible character? Jesus will make those choices when He is preparing a place for us!

### **FALSE GODS**

**Friday ..... Read Joshua 24: 15-18**

*"And if it seem evil unto you to serve the Lord, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."* When God created man as a triune being with a spirit, that means all humans have an innate need to worship. This was intended for humans to be in constant fellowship with God. If a person does not worship God in spirit and in truth, they will worship someone or something. Consequently, there are a lot of false gods as noted in today's Bible reading. How much better to worship the true and living God.

### **ARMY**

**Saturday..... Read Revelation 14:1-5**

*"And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Zion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads."* The reference to Jesus as the Lamb in this verse at the time of coming battle is significant. It demonstrates the fulfillment of the Old Testament prophesy about the lion of Judah in Genesis 49:9 " *Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up?"* The final battle resulting in Jesus becoming the King of kings to rule for one thousand years is an actual war as we know it. There is, however, a spiritual war now to win the souls of people. Satan is using the strategy of false religions and has deceived many. Praise God for all true believers and churches true to God's Word and share His truth.
