“Our God is an AWESOME God”

“The Greatest Miracle”

SundayRead Genesis 1:1-10

Many Believers like to not necessarily argue but discuss what is the greatest miracle that our God has ever done. Personally, I believe that the greatest miracle that our God has ever performed is the creation of the heavens, the earth, and the cosmos. God spoke into existence everything from nothing. I have heard people say that it is impossible for a virgin woman to conceive a child. However, our God first created the earth and then created man from the dust of the ground. If that is true... and it is, how hard can it be for the Holy Spirit of God to place our Lord Jesus in Mary’s womb? That is why I contend that the miracle of creation is the greatest miracle ever. Every thing that human beings have ever made or created needed the raw materials that God originally created from NOTHING!

“God is Our Sustainer”

MondayRead Colossians 1:16-17

Praise God that He NOT only created the heavens and the earth but he sustains it all by His mighty power. *“He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.”* Wow! He holds together everything. I am not sure if you have ever heard of the preacher Louie Giglio. Louie Giglio did a presentation on how God holds us as human beings together. When God created Adam, God created something called laminin. What is laminin? Laminin is a protein that has several jobs but one major job. That job is to “LITERALLY” hold us together. Laminin is a vital glycoprotein network in the extracellular matrix that acts as molecular scaffolding. Its primary function is to provide structural stability to basement membranes, support tissue organization, and mediate critical cellular activities like adhesion, migration, and differentiation. One other function is that it permits our body to heal. Our God is AWESOME!

“Encouragement”

Tuesday.....Read Jeremiah 32:16-22

I think this is what may have happened to the prophet Jeremiah in Chapter 32. *“Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and outstretched arm. “NO EXCUSE”

Wednesday.....Read Psalm 19:1-10

“The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork.” This is what is called or referred to as General Revelation. In other words, our natural world bears witness to the fact that there is a Creator God. Our God is invisible. His power is eternal. His Divine nature made His qualities evident to all human beings that have ever walked the face of this earth. Thursday.....Read Deuteronomy 32:1- 4

Friday.....Read John 3:16-17
